TAILOR-MADE PROGRAMS AT UANDES

Universidad de los Andes (UANDES) is a private, non-profit research university located in Santiago, Chile. UANDES offers 22 undergraduate programs and more than 80 graduate programs, and places special emphasis on research, innovation and development.

Ranked top 3 in Chile according to the National Admissions Test (PSU 2013), our University combines academic excellence and modern infrastructure with green areas where students can find all they need for learning, research, sports and extracurricular activities.

ABOUT OUR PROGRAMS

Universidad de los Andes offers short term and tailor-made programs in summer or winter breaks for international undergraduate and graduate students and Faculty.

These programs can be offered either in English or Spanish, Faculty-led or completely delivered by UANDES professors, in various areas as Spanish and Chilean Culture, Business, Education, Humanities, Law and Engineering, among others.

Programs can be delivered during the whole year, but mainly in July and in January (J-Term).

The programs typically include lectures during the morning and extracurricular activities during the afternoon. At the end of the program, the students will receive a certificate of attendance and academic credits from Universidad de los Andes.



SOME OF OUR CURRENT SPECIAL PROGRAMS:

Spanish as a Foreign Language (ELE):

Universidad de los Andes offers tailor-made courses of Spanish for specific purposes, starting from one-month to four-month courses. These programs include tuition, housing, airport transportation and cultural activities such as study visits and meetings with Chilean students. Courses can be done in basic, intermediate and advanced level.

We can offer courses in the following areas:

- Spanish for Education and Social Studies
- Spanish for Business and Management
- Spanish and Chilean Culture

Institute for Leadership in the Americas:

Students from partner institutions can apply to *The Institute for Leadership in the Americas* (ILA) which features a two-week full time academic program, taught completely in English at Universidad de los Andes during our summer in January. ILA focuses on economics, political theory and the bases for the rule of law and institutional governance. It is held in collaboration with the Washington D.C.-based foundation *The Fund for the American Studies*. More than 50 students from all over the world, including Chilean students, participate in this program.

Former programs done at UANDES include:

"Chile and Children's and Youth Literature" for Spanish Teachers coming from University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, in collaboration with the Fulbright Commission. A one-month program organized by our School of Education with classes, field trips to primary schools and visits to the north and south regions of Chile.

"International Human Rights" for Law Students coming from Valparaiso University, Indiana. A one-week program organized by our School of Law, led by scholars and practitioners from the United States, Chile and Argentina. The students examined legal, historical and cultural approaches to human rights in Chile and Argentina.



INTERNSHIPS

Universidad de los Andes provides practical opportunities for students from abroad.

CLERKSHIP IN HEALTH STUDIES

Short-term student internships at Universidad de los Andes Health Center in San Bernardo or in one of our partner hospitals and clinics in Santiago. Possible for Dentistry, Nursing, Psychology, Kinesiology, Occupational Therapy and Medicine with limited slots.

SUPERVISED TEACHING PRACTICE

Teaching placement in an elementary school in Santiago with additional UANDES Faculty tutorship and a Spanish course at UANDES.

RESEARCH INTERNSHIP

Assistantship to an UANDES professor in a research project with additional Spanish course. (Recommended as additional stay after an exchange semester at UANDES).

PROFESSIONAL PLACEMENT

Working experience as an intern at the International Office or other administrative offices at UANDES (Recommended as additional stay after an exchange semester). UANDES also offers placements for students in further Chilean firms and companies in Santiago.
